I have typically been teaching at the last year of the BA-program and at the last year of the Master-program. I have also taught for 5 years in the Danish Ph.D.-program in Finance.

The courses have varied over the range Real Investments, Financial Theory, Derivatives, and Corporate Finance and Governance. In recent years I have lectured almost only in Corporate Finance and Governance.

I have been adviser on more than 100 Master-theses and around 25 BA-theses.

I have been main (only) adviser for 4 Ph.D.-students (Aarhus University) and secondary advisor for 1 Ph.D.-student (Life, Copenhagen University).

Originally I built up the program in finance at the undergraduate as well at the graduate level (with very few resources) at the Department of Economics and Business Economics.

Finally I have been nominated 5 times for the Lecturer Award (*The Golden Pointer*) at Aarhus University, but I have not received it yet!
