

Minutes of the General Assembly Meeting of the Nordic Econometric Network, October 29, 2009, at the School of Economics and Management, Lund University, Sweden.

1. Election of chairperson and secretary for the meeting:
Anders Klevmarken was elected chairman and Fredrik NG Andersson was elected secretary.
2. Report from the outgoing Steering Committee:
Gunnar Rosenqvist reported on behalf of the steering committee about activities in the past two years. The main activity has been to organize the 5th Nordic Econometric Meeting in Lund. An unusually large number of papers were submitted to the conference.

Gunnar Rosenqvist also informed that a new webpage is presently being constructed.

Report of the financial situation of the network: No financial activities.

3. Future activities:
Next meeting in Aarhus, 2011.

As consequence of the large number of submissions to the meeting in Lund, about 50% of the submissions were rejected. Among those were a large number of Ph.D. students. It was discussed whether Ph.D. students should be given priority over senior researchers in the reviewing process. It was decided that no special rules should apply, but the steering committee and the local organizers may decide on special sessions for Ph.D. students during future econometric meetings.

4. Election of a new steering committee:
The outgoing committee was re-elected.
5. Decision about membership dues:
No fees.
